

Pregnancy and Adoption Support Program Needs

Catholic Charities' Pregnancy and Adoption Support program serves expectant families throughout the Diocese of Arlington who are faced with unexpected or crisis pregnancies.

We do this through providing case management services, counseling, referrals for services, necessary baby items through our baby closet, life affirming options counseling surrounding parenting and adoption planning options, and by facilitating adoption related services for woman who choose to make an adoption plan for their child (aka Birth Mother's). We also are a lifetime resource to any of our clients who adopted, been adopted or placed a child for adoption.

We cannot do this important pro-life work without the generous support of community partners, donors and volunteers. Below is a list of needs for our program that will better equip us in serving our clients and providing transformative services to those in need.

Baby Closet Needs

CCDA has a baby closet with donations for infants ages 0-24 months which can be provided to our current clients or which can be accessed by the public (one time only) during designated hours at which time we are able to assess the needs of the family and provide what we can from the baby closet.

Please note: <u>Only new or gently used clothing</u> can be accepted Other gently used baby items can be accepted upon inspection from CCDA staff

Items most frequently requested and most in need:

- Brand new infant car seats (with 5-point harness)
- Grocery Gift Cards (e.g. Giant, Safeway)
- Uber or Lyft Gift Cards
- Disposable diapers in sizes: Newborn, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 (sizes 2-4 are most requested)
- Newborn clothing in sizes: 3 months-24monthes
- Wipes

In addition to the items needed for our baby closet, our program is in great need for the below donations that help us to serve woman and families while they are expecting their child. Providing quality support and stabilization is essential to the client and the unborn child's safety and development.

Post Adoption Support Needs

Parents who make the selfless decision to place their child for adoption do so because they want what is best for their child and because they know they are not able to provide that. We are dedicated to serving these parents for a lifetime to ensure that they have access to grief counseling and support services to ensure they have hope for their future and are at peace with their decision.

- **Birthparent Scholarship Funding.** We aim to stay involved with our birthparents and help them achieve their educational and career goals. Having funding available for professional certifications and/or advanced education options opens many doors and can create sustainable stability. Your generous contribution could help pave the way for our birthparents. Here are some examples of opportunities for growth:
 - Did you know that <u>Hogar Education</u> offers classes for GED, child care, and citizenship ranging from only \$100 - \$225 per class? They are offered in English and Spanish too!
 - Did you know <u>adult ESOL classes</u> are available through local counties ranging from \$185 \$300 for 10-week courses?
 - Did you know <u>Adult & Community Education</u> classes are available through local counties ranging from \$300-\$400 per class? They offer certificate programs such as administrative assistant, child care, medical or dental assistant, and many more.
- **Fundraising for birthparent groups and annual events**. Each month we host a support group for women who have placed children for adoption to provide ongoing support months or years after placement. We also host an annual event in the community for our birthparents on Birthmother's Day in May. In the past we have
