Fast Facts about Migration and Refugee Services:

- Serves about 3,000 refugee clients a year
- Welcomed 417 individual refugees or 120 cases, the majority of which were from Afghanistan with SIV status, meaning they had assisted the U.S. government or military while in their home country.
- Assisted 600 refugees (both new arrivals and existing clients) with job placements, ranging from refugee's first job to career advancement, including promotions or successively better jobs.
- Served 500 refugee children with school supplies, school support, tutoring through the Virginia Refugee Student Achievement Project.
- Mentored 50 refugee youth through Mentoring Youth in Virginia program for older refugee youth.
- Assisted 75 senior refugees through Serving Older Refugees program with case management, assistance with medical bills, social activities and employment.
